2-3 lbs of venision steaks
1/4 tsp. salt
1/2 tsp. garlic salt
1 T. minced onion
1/8 tsp. pepper
1 T. lemon juice
2 103/4 cans of cream of mushroom soup
1/2 cup of water
1/2 cup of dry red wine

Trim fat from steaks, dredge the steaks in flour, brown in small amount of oil. Put in shallow dish in layers. Mix the rest of ingredients and pour over steaks. Bake in oven at 350 for 2 1/2 hrs. This can also be put in a crock pot for 4-5 hours on high. Thanks Barbara ! As in all these recipes, if you have the first item, the rest is easy!

I had the pin on "the" spot and let the Muzzy fly. I shortly holding a main frame 10 pointer with 13 scoring points and weighing 300 pounds on huff. The monster, I now call the Creek Bottom Gangster, scores 153 5/8 inch.

I give God all the glory for blessing me with a chance to harvest one of his finest creatures. By now, the State NFAA-MBH Indoor Championship is over and congratulations to everyone.
