There is still some good hunting left this season. Remember to send Jack your game reports! All the forms can be found on the website, www.mobowhunters.org. There are some nice awards given for turning in these reports. The awards are given out at the Missouri Deer Classic in March.

There will be a Board of Representatives meeting January 9, 2011 in Columbia. Last year there was some interest by several clubs to host the 3D. If your club is interested in hosting the 3D, or any of the other state shoots, bring a bid to the meeting. It would be a whole lot easier to settle on these issues at the January meeting than having more meetings in the year. 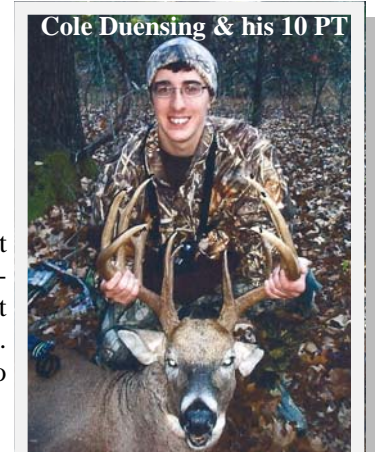

Mediterranean Steaks :

- 2-3 lbs of venison steaks
- 1/4 tsp. salt
- 1/2 tsp. garlic salt
- 1 T. minced onion
- 1/8 tsp. pepper
- 1 T. lemon juice
- 2 103/4 cans of cream of mushroom soup
- 1/2 cup of water
- 1/2 cup of dry red wine

Trim fat from steaks, dredge the steaks in flour, brown in small amount of oil. Put in shallow dish in layers. Mix the rest of ingredients and pour over steaks. Bake in oven at 350 for 2 1/2 hrs. This can also be put in a crock pot for 4-5 hours on high. Thanks Barbara ! As in all these recipes, if you have the first item, the rest is easy!

The monster, I now call the Creek Bottom Gangster, scores 153 5/8 inch.

I give God all the glory for blessing me with a chance to harvest one of his finest creatures. By now, the State NFAA-MBH Indoor Championship is over and congratulations to everyone.
