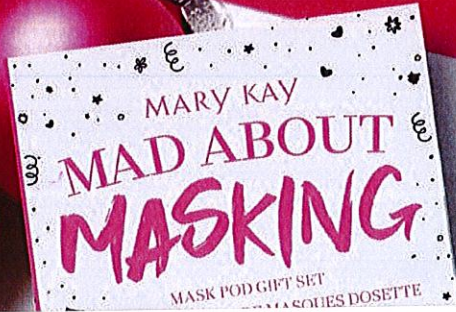

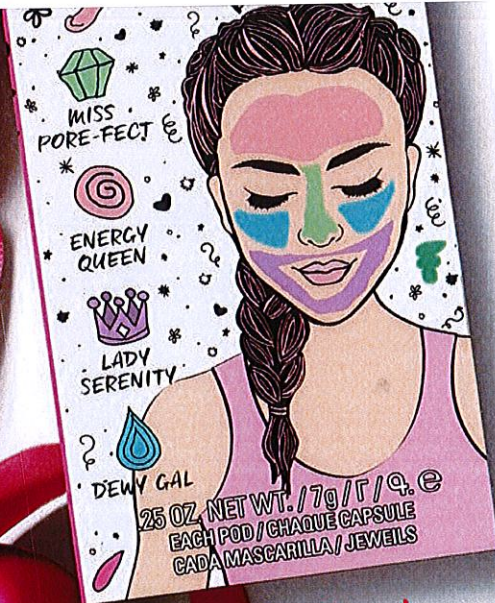

CONSERVATION COMMITTEE REPORT

News and interesting tidbits from The Missouri Department of Conservation.

MDC warns of nuisance black vultures at Bagnell Dam Access on Osage River

Area users should beware of potential damage to parked vehicles.

LAKE OZARK, Mo. – The Missouri Department of Conservation (MDC) advises area users at Bagnell Dam Access on the Osage River to beware of potential damage to parked vehicles due to black vultures.

MDC has worked to harass these birds and remove some of them, but they continue to congregate in this area despite deterrence efforts. MDC also has signs posted at Bagnell Dam Access alerting area users of the potential nuisance threat.

“MDC and conservation partners in the area are working to try to deter these vultures, but black vultures can be aggressive and persistent,” said MDC Wildlife Regional Supervisor John George. “It may make sense for area users to take precautions such as covering their vehicles with tarps and straps. However, even these precautions do not necessarily guarantee full protection.

Fall Color Hot Spots

If you're up for a hike, this is a great time to visit Hart Creek Conservation Area in southern Boone County. Located on the hills overlooking the Missouri River, the protected slopes are home to showy sugar maples, and oaks and aromatic sumac are abundant on the ridgetops. All the colors of autumn, combined with the sweeping vista of the Missouri River, should make for the perfect hike.

Kansas City Region

Fall Color Hot Spots

For scenic fall color drives in our region, drive on MO 45 and MO 224 along the Missouri River. For hiking and photography, we recommend Big Buffalo Creek, Burr Oak Woods, and White Alloe Creek Conservation Areas; Maple Woods Natural Area; Knob Noster State Park; Forest Hills and Mount Washington cemeteries, and the Swope Memorial in Swope Park. If you're looking for fall color in and near the city, VisitKC.com has lots of other ideas for you.

LARGE & SMALL GAME COMMITTEE

Sweet November! Well it finally cooled off halfway through October. Weather has been great to get outside and hunt. I haven't received any harvest reports from MBH members yet.

I started my MDC managed hunt at Longview Lake in the suburbs of Lee's Summit the week of October 20th. I am still dedicated to using my recurve so far but I must admit it's a lot tougher to fill my tags than I expected. I figured in a target rich environment like Longview Lake I would get lots of opportunities to punch the required doe tag early and then spend my time chasing a good buck. Well it's not quite as I had hoped so far. I've been out eight times and I do see deer every time, although I haven't see any decent bucks yet, including at least three times I could have filled my doe tag with my compound bow but I've only had one chance with my traditional gear which was on the ground at 24 yards while walking back to the truck. My arrow sailed over the does back as she was on high alert watching me and ducked at the shot. I should have aimed lower figuring the doe would drop down to spring away at the sound of the shot. On October 29th I had an interesting but somewhat frustrating morning. Cold front blew through the night before with rain most of the night. I expected the deer to move on the oak ridge where my stand was however I didn't see a deer until 9 am when a doe came through at 30 yards acting like she was running from something. It was too far for a shot with my recurve. Ten minutes later a solid P&Y nine pointer came through following the doe with his nose to the ground. Ten minutes after that another good buck showed up but this one decided to eat acorns only 13 yards from my tree stand. That guy had a wide rack with a split brow tine on the right side. I definitely would have taken the shot only I still haven't killed the required doe to earn my buck tag. AAAAAGGGGGGAAAAAA! I could only take a picture with my cell phone.



The hunt lasts through November 10th so I've still got time to get it done. My running tally at this point on the comparison between what I feel are chances with my compound as compared to my traditional gear are; Traditional Gear Chances = 4 and Compound Gear Chances = 8.

Seeing those bucks and does at 30 yards definitely has me thinking about picking my compound back up to extend my range a little. There is still a week left in the managed hunt and I hope I can take advantage of this opportunity.
