

MISSOURI BOW HUNTERS

SMALL GAME AWARD

This is awarded on the honor system -- between the individual bow hunter and his state association. It is a system of awards based on certain point values on species of wildlife. To be credited with the point values, the bow hunter must take the game legally and conform to certain basic rules of the system. Check the wildlife code book for rules and regulations.

A permanent record of the individual hunter is kept. Upon request the MBH Large and Small Game Committee will send you a card to record the information on your kills.

For the purpose of making awards, various small game may be given the following point values:

When (30) points have been achieved, the MBH Small Game Award is given, the first (30) points award shall be the Small Game Pin. The pin is gold and shaped like an arrow-head.

After each (30) points thereafter the award will be a gold numeral and chain, -- up to a maximum of (10) awards.

Bobcat (South of Hwy 70)	30 Check regulations
Bullfrog	1/2*
Coyote	30 (10) if with aid of dogs
Groundhog (woodchuck)	6
Fox (Red & Gray)	30 Check regulations
Opossum	2
Rabbits (cottontail)	3
Raccoon	5
Skunk (striped only) (spotted is on endangered list)	2
Squirrel	4
Weasel	4
Crow	6
Dove	5
Duck	5
Goose	5
Pheasant	3
Quail or Bobwhite	3
Fish, those legal to take with bow	1*
Turtles, water, not land terrapin	1*
Gar, must be landed	2

Not over 8 of the points necessary to win the Small Game Award may be made on any of the above indicated by *.

Not over 15 points may be made on any single kind of game.

Not over 23 points may be made on any two kinds of game.

All kills must be reported to the Chairman within 90 days or credit will not be allowed.

An entry fee of \$2.00 must accompany the first application for Small Game Award subsequent awards.
